FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Lord is truly Risen! Alleluia!

Dear parishioners of Ste. Anne Parish,

Happy Easter! Although this Easter Sunday might not be celebrated in the usually way, there is nothing in this world, no plague, no feelings of isolation, no worries about thefuture, that can take away the joy we are invited to experience in the resurrection of Jesus from the dead.

Special thanks to our parish staff and communications team who have assisted us in the live-streaming of the Holy Week celebrations, so that we could all be united in prayer in this most special week of our Church year. May your dedication and sharing of talents be blessed!

I came across an image this past week on social media; the image had a picture of an empty church right next to a picture of the empty tomb. There were no words attached to the image - many times a picture does speak a thousand words! What came to my heart, in seeing these pictures side by side, is that I should not underestimate what God can do with our empty churches these days, for the empty tomb became a launching point for the disciples to encounter the Risen Lord. As we know very well, the empty tomb doesn't itself prove the event of the resurrection; many explanations could have been possible. Mary Magdalene herself thought somebody had taken Jesus' body, but God has the power to fill emptiness of any kind! Even the emptiness of death He fills with new life! Jesus approached Mary, near the tomb, and through her tears she sees Jesus standing next to her, when He calls her by name, she realizes that it is the Lord and goes to announce to the other disciples -"I have seen the Lord!"

Emptiness of different kinds may be an experience we are all facing these days. Our homes may feel empty with no visitors coming by, our hearts may feel empty due to the uncertainties all around us, our churches feel empty for lack of a congregation, what do we do with all of this emptiness? We can take our cue from Mary Magdalene and the apostles Peter and John, we press on towards the empty tombs we are experiencing and we wait to encounter Christ there in the void – even if it causes some tears as it did with Mary Magdalene. "Sometimes in our life tears are the glasses to see Jesus," says Pope Francis. Once these disciples have encountered the Risen Lord through the sign of the empty tomb, they become missionaries; they immediately are burning with desire to share the powerful Good News of the resurrection and new life with others.

Our world today is in need of such missionaries of the resurrection. This Easter, as we refrain for health and safety reasons, from physical visits and gatherings at our parish church, let us send to our family and friends messages, phone calls, videos and text messages of new life! May all of us who experience some form of emptiness this Easter be filled with the love of the one who knows no emptiness at all – Jesus, the Risen Lord!
