We will also continue to support the Arthritis Society, to help fund research to cure this horrible and debilitating condition.

Each Knights of Columbus local council that is

participating in the sale of tickets will also receive a portion of the funds to support a local initiative or charity in their area. It's a wonderful way to show support for programs that directly impact our local community. Since the lottery program began, the Knights of Columbus Ontario Charities Foundation has donated over 10 million dollars to local non-profit organizations across Ontario.

This year there are 500 prizes with a grand prize of \$200,000 cash!!! . There are 10 grand prizes and 490 additional prizes for a total valued at over \$500,000. One of the worthy groups benefiting is the Special Olympics. The raffle is provincially licensed under the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Commission and the license is held by the Knights of Columbus Ontario Charity Foundation Inc. This photo depicts the resourcefulness of the family of the late Sir Knight of Wilfrid Langlois Assembly 1789 and Brother Knight of Victor Cote Council 9671 **Ron Gauthier** on the personalization of the Heritage Brick that was gifted to the family by the Assembly. This brick will be added to the 'Knights' Walk' at the Venerable Fr. Michael J. McGivney Statue site at Heavenly Rest Cemetery. The token of a brick such as this along with a monetary donation to the preferred charity of choice of the family of a deceased Sir Knight is becoming a fitting option in place of a chalice which of late, has doubled in price. It has now become the accepted procedure that, prior to a family accepting a chalice on behalf of the assembly, the family will be responsible in finding someone who will accept and use the chalice.

Update on E Membership Program

On January 16th we launched the new E Membership program here in Ontario. In the first 15 days we recruited 11 new brother knights into the order through this program. Of these 11 brothers 8 identified wishing to join a local council. In the pilot states in America they showed 60% of members joined a local council, our numbers currently show 72% wish to join a local council. The average age of the brothers who joined is 31. Brothers these numbers show that this program works. With no effort from the councils our order became 11 men stronger and local councils gained 8 young active members. I ask that you bring these numbers to your local councils and explain to them the benefit of this program as a recruitment tool. Your councils can sign a member without having to wait for an Admission degree and risk losing them due to the wait. Those men who are on the fence about joining, this is for them. It gives them a taste of the knights without a commitment and through the program will lean to our side of the fence and join a local council. Remember E Members are Members with all the same rights and privileges minus the right to vote and hold office, please treat them as such as they are our brothers. 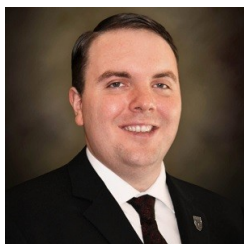
